Updated: August 25, 2021

Colorado LTAP's priority and commitment is to keep our communities safe. We have developed the following COVID-19 protocols which closely follow guidance from national, state and local health experts. For in-person trainings, we will look to local mandates/guidelines, followed by the state and federal levels.

The CDC currently recommends that all individuals, regardless of vaccine status, wear masks in indoor public places in counties with "high" or "substantial" spread of COVID-19.
